FROM THE EDITORS

Compared to previous years, 2006 had a large number of patches, probably more so than any previous year covered. between NOAC, anniversaries, emergence of more and more chapter items, FO\$, Wood Badge and Eagle Scout CSPs, it was meant to be big. The void of a lack of a National Conference in 2007 will likely be filled by various Florida entities making World Jamboree and 100th Anniversary of world Scouting items. And we are already seeing more OA chapter emblems coming.

Sunshine Trade-O-Ree. The 19th annual Sunshine Trade-O-Ree took place in mid February. And while a fun time was had by one and all, and all of the tables were sold prior to the opening of the event, several familiar faces were missing. Understandable that some can't make the long drives anymore, or other events that conflicted with the weekend. If you didn't make it there, you were missed. But the organizers are considering a Summer Trade-O-Ree, in late August or September. Stay tuned....

In the last issue we had written about fakes found from over forty years ago, that have been recently discovered. At this time, we don't have enough together to pull together a full story that tells of the Florida patches in question, and the full story has not yet been written by the national collectors that have done their homework. We

hope to have it in the next issue.

But there's more fakes! Seems that anyone with a few bucks, a bad drawing of older OA emblems, and access to cheap Chinese embroidery is trying to get money on eBay from the sale of "historical reproductions". Who are they kidding?? We have three pictured in this issue, and they don't even look close to the original, no matter how much one may squint while looking at them. These three are but a few of the many that have been made by multiple sellers.

Lodge numbers. National made a decision a few years back that led to lots of wailing and gnashing of teeth, to eliminate the use of lodge numbers as identification, and that any number that would be used would be the council number that holds the lodge charter. But when the *Scouting* magazine of January/ February 2007 had an article about the 2006 NOAC, all the lodges named had their old numbers included. Seems the editor didn't get the memo.

NEW ISSUES

- > **Tipisa Lodge 326** celebrated their 60th anniversary at the beginning of 2007, with the release of their 60th anniversary flap (S-40). A new chenille (C-5) measures 8 1/2 inches across, and is completely chenilled. The lodge also made a new jacket patch (J-7), featuring the totems of their 14 chapters, set in a map of the lodge.
- * Astatula Chapter has a new patch (X-3), celebrating their 5th anniversary.
- > Echockotee Lodge 200 has started the year with a band new service flap (S-31), measuring 65 mm x 122 mm, and computer stitched.. One thousand were made, to be sold at one for every eight hours of service.
- * Apieka Chapter has a new patch (X-2), with 200 made.

Oddly enough, there seem to be more council strips than OA emblems for this issue:

- > Central Florida Council has their annual set of three FO\$ council shoulder patches: SMY border (SA-78), GMY border (SA-79), and the Baden-Powell Club (SA-80).
- > Gulf Ridge Council has two new 2007 Wood Badge CSPs (SA-40; ORG fdl; regular participant; SA-41; GLD fdl; staff). One hundred was made of each.
- > South Florida Council has two new CSPs of their own. First, an "Eagle Sponsor" (SA-30), for donors for an Eagle Scout event, and also an FO\$ issue (SA-31).
- > Not pictured: the latest FO\$ from North Florida Council (SA-37).

THE RUMOR MILL

Some are rumored to be made, others are just facts waiting to come true.....

- * For the upcoming Section S-4S Conference, Echockotee Lodge 200 has gone slightly nuts. Samples have been made and orders have been taken for an unrestricted host flap (S-32), pocket patch, jacket patch, neckerchief, and chenille. Also being made, and available for lodge embers attending the Section Conference, there will be a host council shoulder patch, that will also commemorate the two national championships being held by the University of Florida Gators basketball and football teams. Elemukulek Chapter has been accepting orders for their first patch; these should be delivered at the Spring Fellowship weekend.
- * O-Shot-Caw Lodge 265's own Alex Gomez was elected Southern Region chief. Expect at least one commemorative flap in his honor. There is also the expected "regular" issue that was to be released at the Lodge Banquet (prototype has been pictured). The order has been delayed.
- * Yustaga Lodge 385 has been advertising a special commemorative flap, honoring long-time chapter advisor Frank Henry, who suddenly passed away last year. The lodge has also been advertising a special patch to rise funds for Whipple Circle, a facility at Camp Euchee.
- * Timuquan Lodge 340's Hiyaraba Chapter will make a new patch, to fit under the flap, and is a complete departure from their previous issues.

- * Long-term planning: Central Florida Council will make a special CSP for the 20th Anniversary of the Sunshine Trade-O-Ree. In 2008.
- * Speaking of the Trade-O-Ree, there is a chance that there could be a second annual event, possibly in late August or September. Organizers are still considering the feasibility of this additional activity.

Notes & Asides

- > The activity patches for his year from Tipisa Lodge 326 will have an extra, smaller piece that won't match the set. The badge for the 2006-07 Chapter Ordeals came back smaller than requested, which will have a major impact in any puzzle set. A new corrected version is being ordered.
- > Camp Sawyer fans: a benefactor from Key West has made a million dollar donation for improvements to the camp, helping to fulfill the plan to build a multi-level dining hall, a ranger house, and proper sewage facilities. No word as to when the construction begins.
- > For the last few months, a seller on eBay has been offering for sale the production artwork for several Florida OA flaps and other patches. The artwork, hand-drawn on heavy cardboard stock, usually measures between 18 and 24 inches wide, and has the notes from the employee working on the rendering. All of these appear to have been for patches ordered from Midwest Swiss Embroidery of Chicago, and some are for patches made in the 1950s.

- > More news from eBay. For some folks that are really, *really* desperate for a patch that is purported to look like a flap from Chiriqui Lodge 391, someone from the Far East has made them available (pictured in this issue). But note that no one will ever mistake them for the real thing.
- > Is laser cut the latest trend? Both Echockotee and O-Shot-Caw are making laser-cut activity patches this year, and several lodges in the Carolinas have made them for the last few years for their own activities.
- > For the troops formed in the Southern Region for the World Jamboree, the word has gone out from the Regional office that all emblems needs to be approved prior to production. This means the design and the manufacturer of the patch, which means that it needs to be made by one of three BSA approved vendors. Imagine that professional's chagrin when his home lodge in Atlanta made three flaps for the World Jamboree, without seeking or getting his approval.
- > One of our long-time advertisers, Roger Ward of Siesta Beach Trading Company, has fully established himself separately from his previous employment with Brush Creek. Roger is presently heavily involved with the disposition of the John Conley Williams collection, with several major and rare pieces now becoming available.






